ATTENDANCE:

As per Rule SANT GADGE BABA AMRAVATI UNIVERSITY, ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 2001. Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Engineering (Four year Degree Course... Semester pattern) Ordinance 2001 item number 9 (b) (As amended by Ordinance No. 25 of 2001, 5 of 2003, 2 of 2005, 43 of 2005, & 12 of 2009), minimum 75% attendance in theory and practical classes is compulsory. Your Parents will be informed of default in attendance and poor performance in exams and fine may be imposed on you. You may also be detained from university examinations as per rule.



INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Marks for theory and practical will be displayed on notice board. Marks are based on two class tests, journals, viva voce and performance respectively. Class Attendance carries 5 marks. Valued answer papers of class test will be available for your review up to 15 days from the test. You must assess your performance & improve on it. Previous university question papers and question banks as well as up-to-date lab manuals are available with department.

CULTURAL & TECHNICAL PROGRAMS

Attend maximum such programs which are meant for personality development. Look out for notice boards for their schedules.

MORAL VALUES

Ragging is a crime. Do not indulge in it. Behave as a cultured human being with full regards for moral, ethical and spiritual values including respect for elders and ladies.

CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- 1. English is the language for communication in the college.
- 2. All the students are expected to attend college on the reopening day after each of the vacations. Tardy arrivals after vacations are liable to be fined.
- 3. Students should realize that they are responsible to the college authorities not only for their conduct in the college but also for their general behaviour outside. On their way to or from college the student must remember that the college is judged by their conduct.
- 4. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than three days, habitual idleness, disobedience objectionable moral influence, above all discourtesy and disrespect to teachers are each a sufficient cause for dismissal.
- 5. A student who has been absent for more than three days at a stretch of illness, is expected to bring doctor's certificate along with application before returning to college. He /She should inform on very first day of illness to Class Teacher / the HOD.
- 6. Student who has been absent from college without prior permission from the Class Teacher / the HOD or is late for more than three times a week will not be allowed to attain classes without the HOD's permission.
- 7. Students who are absent from the Institute continuously for two weeks without permission from the HOD, may not be permitted to continue in the semester and may be asked to drop the semester, unless satisfactory explanation of their absence, as given by them through HOD, is duly accepted by the Principal.
- 8. Student participating in co-curricular activities (NSS, Sports, Cultural, Youth Festival, Technical paper presentation, industrial training/visit, etc.) should take prior permission from the class teacher / the HOD.
- 9. When the students go for recess, break, games or move along the corridor or up and down the stairs as when changing classes or labs they must walk in discipline and in silence.

- 10. Every Student is urged to contribute to the high tone of the college by their good manner and gentlemanly conduct.
- 11. For the smooth running of the college any object liable to prove a source of disturbance e.g. mobiles, audio devices, magazines or papers etc. if found in the possession of the student make them liable for severe punishment. Running, playing or shouting inside the college building is never allowed.
- 12. Any damages done in, or about the college premises or to the college property must be made good by the parent of the student responsible. If the offender is not discovered a collective fine may be imposed upon the entire class. The decision of HOD and the Principal regarding the amount to be paid is final.
- 13. Students leaving the premises of the college in the course of the day will have to take the written permission from the Class Teacher. Repeated defaulters are liable to be dismissed.
- 14. No student is allowed to remain in the computer center during theory lecture or laboratory period. Students from one section are not permitted to enter another section.
- 15. No obscene books or magazines may be brought into college premises by the students. Students found with obscene books or pictures in their possession or lending them to others are liable to be expelled from college.
- 16. Personal cleanliness is expected from all. The Uniform must be clean and neatly pressed. Every student must have a complete outfit or everything that is necessary or prescribed by the college authorities. All students must use their own materials and they are themselves responsible for the safety of the same.
- 17. All should take an honest pride in keeping their college clean. Be very careful during the recess and otherwise not to litter the floor, the compound and roadside with papers, leaves seeds etc. Please make use of the paper bins provided for the purpose.
- 18. The college does not accept responsibility of the loss of cell phone, laptop, books, pens, money and so on. It is not advisable for the students to have large sums of money or other valuable ornaments or articles with them.
- 19. No collection for any purpose whatsoever is to be started and no meeting, demonstration, party or picnic may be held without the previous permission of HOD and the Principal.
- 20. Presents to members of the staff or other demonstration in their honor also requires previous sanction of the Principal.
- 21. Serious action may be taken by the Principal only or with his express permission, for faults against discipline, against regularity and in the case of unsanctioned leave.
- 22. Reports on conduct, application and progress are issued after every class test. Result sheet is sent to parents by post from time to time. On the day after day they are issued, they have to be shown to the class teacher, duly signed and dated by the parents and guardians.
- 23. Any students who is persistently insubordinate or is repeatedly or willfully mischievous or is guilty of malpractice in connection with examinations or of unauthorized alternation in leaving certificates, or who, in the opinion of the Principal or HOD has unwholesome influence on his fellow pupils, may be removed from the rolls. The removal may be temporary or permanent according to the gravity of the offence.

RAGGING CIRCULAR / GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

RAGGING CIRCULAR

Applicable First Year to Final Year Students admitted in academic year 2017-2018 till the completion of engineering course

Action against ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act XXXIII of 1999 which is in effect from 15th May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.

- a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited,
- b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complaints, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he /she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

- 4. If a student is likely to be absent through illness for more than three days, Class Teacher and HOD must be informed immediately.
- 5. Parents are requested to pay fees and dues of their ward on schedule dates to avoid penalties and convenience to system
